



The Ultimate Change of Address Checklist

Moving your life is more than just moving boxes. Use this checklist to ensure your mail follows you and your records stay accurate.

Government & Official

- DVLA: Update your driving licence and vehicle registration (V5C). It is a legal requirement and free to do online.
- HMRC: Update your personal tax account for Income Tax and National Insurance.
- Electoral Register: Re-register at your new address to maintain your credit score and voting rights.
- DWP: If applicable, notify the Pension Service or Jobcentre Plus.

Financial Services

- Banks & Building Societies: Update your primary billing address for all accounts.
- Credit Cards: Ensure your "statement address" matches your new home to avoid declined transactions.
- Insurances: Update your car, life, pet, and health insurance. Note: Moving can sometimes change your car insurance premium!
- Pensions: Contact any private pension providers.

Utilities & Home (The Tili Shortcut)

- [] Council Tax: Notify your old and new local authorities.
- [] Water: Close your account with your current supplier.
- [] Energy: Provide final meter readings to your gas and electricity providers.
- [] TV Licence: Move your licence to your new address online.
- [] Broadband & Media: Arrange the "switch-on" date for your new home.

Health & Lifestyle

- [] GP & Dentist: Register with a new practice if you are moving out of the area.
- [] Employer: Ensure your HR department has your new address for your P60 and payslips.
- [] Subscriptions: Update Amazon, eBay, and any monthly delivery boxes (like HelloFresh or Gousto).
- [] Vet: Update your pet's microchip database records.

The "Safety Net"

- [] Royal Mail Redirection: Set this up at least 5 days before you move. It catches any mail you might have forgotten to update manually.
